Cape Byron High School Geographers have had a busy time so far this year, learning about the world around them and many of the issues facing the planet now and in the future.

Students from Cape Byron challenged their geographical skills and knowledge in the National Geographic Geography Competition, which was held on April 9th. 25 students from Classes 7 to 11 volunteered their time to give the competition a go, a great effort from those students. During our High School assembly last week (August 21st) all participants were awarded a certificate to commemorate their participation in the competition. A number of students from our school scored exceptionally well, - Robbie Clapham (Class 9) achieved a High Distinction, Max Taylor (Class 9) and Finn Ellis (Class 7) achieved a Distinction, and Rosie Garvan (Class 7), Zoe Wesolowski-Fisher (Class 8), Taleb Bench-Kanjou (Class 9) and Andy McEwan-Bertock (Class 11) achieved a Credit. Well done to all participants, it was an outstanding result!

Class 10 has been busy investigating Australia's water problems, which included a wonderful day excursion to Rocky Creek Dam and The Nightcap Water Treatment Plant on Thursday August 7th. We were accompanied by Barbara Jensen, the Rous Water Education Officer, who provided the class with insight into the issues facing the provision of water in our region, and some of their plans for the future. We came away with a greater appreciation of the work and planning that goes into supplying us all with drinkable water, and the need to use this precious resource carefully. Students also came away with an appreciation of the wonderful new playground at Rocky Creek Dam; it's well worth a visit.
